USAID MVDP Mission

- To accelerate development of vaccines that can be incorporated into control programs to alleviate malaria morbidity and mortality in developing countries

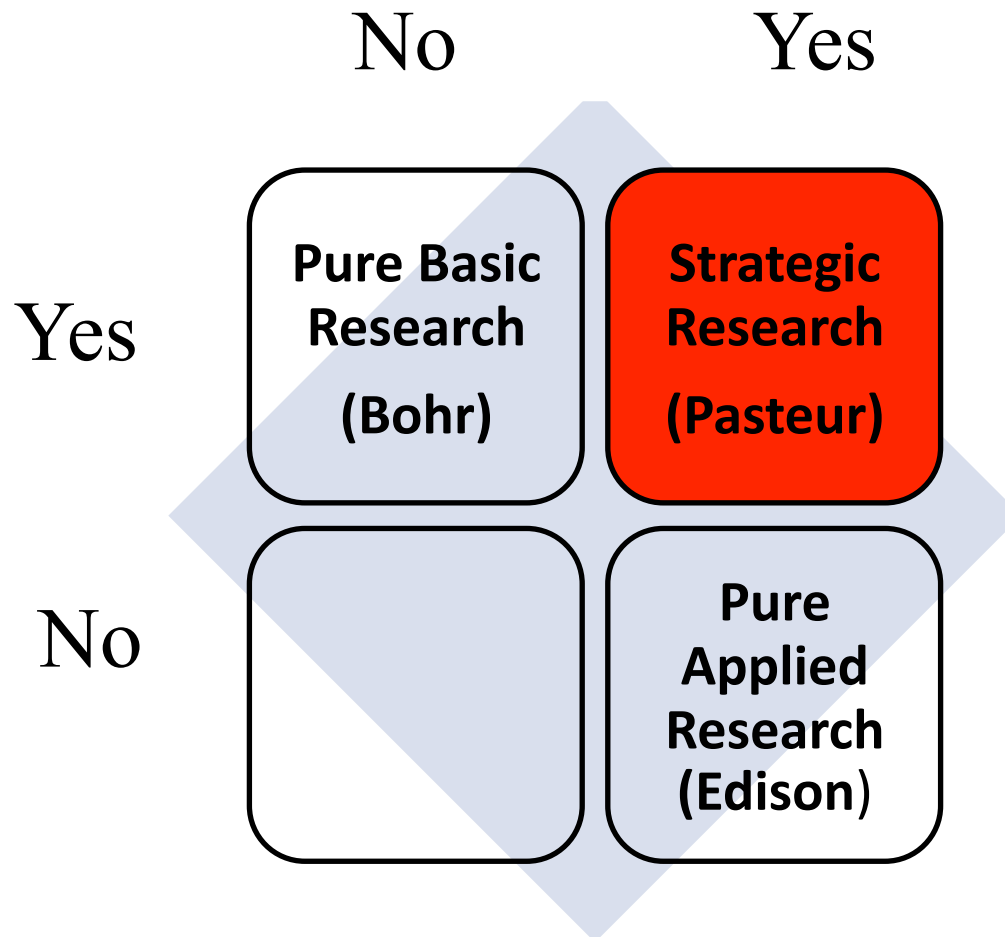
Major USAID MVDP Strategic Elements

- Develop vaccine concepts designed to lead to practical vaccines and accomplish the mission
- For each concept, envision a pathway to introduction of the vaccine that:
 - protects freedom to operate in research & development,
 - protects IP to enable leverage
 - includes a plausible scenario for advanced development, manufacture, licensure, and introduction at an affordable price
- Engage with partners to develop an implementation plan
- Move to clinic/field as soon as prudent to enable test of concept and decision for abandonment or advanced development
